## Dates:

- **Day 2 (1st August):** Proceedings will begin at 9:00 AM and continue until 8:00 PM, consisting of full-day committee sessions, activities, and engagements.
- **Day 3 (2nd August):** The event will again run from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM, concluding with final sessions, closing ceremony, and awards distribution.

# COMMITTEES



**PNA**

A domestic parliamentary simulation centered on legislative affairs, public policy, constitutional matters, and national governance.



**UNHRC**

Responsible for promoting and safeguarding human rights, evaluating policy frameworks, and addressing violations through international cooperation.

# COMMITTEES



## DISEC

Focused on matters relating to global security, arms regulation, disarmament policies and the peaceful use of emerging defence technologies.



## WORLD COUNCIL

A specialized crisis committee with real-time, scenario-based body requiring rapid analysis, strategic adaptability, and decisive negotiation under evolving conditions allowing delegates to shape the course of events.

# COMMITTEES



UNSC

Mandated to maintain international peace and security through binding resolutions, conflict response, and high-level multilateral decision-making.



UNCSW

UN Women is the UN entity dedicated to gender equality and women's empowerment, and implementing standards through laws, policies, and programs to benefit women and girls worldwide.

# CODE OF CONDUCT

Delegates must refrain from abusive, offensive, or discriminatory language toward fellow delegates, staff, or any event participants. Violation will result in written warnings and if repeated, disqualification.

Delegates are expected to maintain diplomatic etiquette at all times, addressing the committee rather than individuals directly and yielding respectfully when recognized by the Chair. Violation will result in suited penalties which may affect scoring.

All delegates are expected to strictly comply with the event schedule. Late arrivals may result in denied entry to committee sessions.

Formal attire is mandatory throughout the event. School or institution uniforms are also acceptable.

Delegates found using false identities will face immediate disqualification. No refunds will be provided in such cases.

All delegates are responsible for their possessions and personal items, including their mobile phones, laptops, chargers etc

Delegates are not permitted to bring items such as makeup products, perfumes and anything which comes under this category. Otherwise, it will result in confiscation.

# CODE OF CONDUCT

Delegates shall not use any recording devices in committee rooms without prior permission from the Executive Committee. Otherwise, it will result in the confiscation of the device.

Identification tags must be worn at all times during the event, or else entry will be denied.

Usage of intoxicants, tobacco products, or harmful substances is strictly forbidden. Violation will result in disqualification and removal from premises.

Discriminatory behavior, harassment, or physical violence in any form will not be tolerated and will result in immediate disqualification.

Failure to abide by this code will result in penalties including warnings, disqualification, or other actions determined by the Executive Committee. These decisions are final and binding.

# EQUITY POLICY

**Respect & Conduct** Maintain respectful, diplomatic, and constructive communication at all times.

**Harassment & Safety** Bullying, harassment, or any violation of consent is strictly prohibited.

**Attire & Decorum** Wear formal, culturally appropriate attire disruptive behavior is not allowed.

**Property & Venue** Damage or misuse of conference property will be penalized.

**Weapons & Substances** Bringing weapons, drugs, alcohol, or harmful items is forbidden.

**Defamatory Behavior** False, hateful, or targeted statements are not tolerated.

**Reporting & Confidentiality** Report concerns to the Equity Team all reports remain confidential.

**Accountability & Consequences** Violations may result in warnings, removal, disqualification, or expulsion.

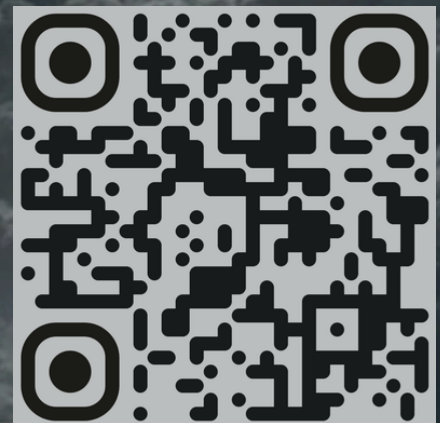
